Phone web interface

Making a call

Make/accept a call via a softphone/PC client

- 2. Make sure your softphone or PC client (Skype, Lync, ...) are set for Conference IP1850 to be the default audio device. Press PC SPK soft key.
- 3. Make or accept your call on your PC application. Audio will be routed to/from IP1850.

Put a call on hold

Press key ... To retrieve the call press Resume soft key.

Note: with more than one active call, select desired call with the navigator keys corresponding soft key to hold or resume.



3-party conference

Call forward

Blind transfer:
