
## **FIRST INSTALLATION**

### **Connecting the Base**

- 1. Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the telephone jack on base bottom. (Fig. A)
- 2. Plug the small end of power adapter into a power jack on base bottom. (Fig. B)
- 3. Plug the large end of power adapter into a wall power outlet. (Fig. C)
- 4. Plug the other end of the telephone line cord in to the telephone jack or micro-filter.
- 5. Always use the cables provided in the box.
- For Duo/Trio version, plug the power adaptor of the charger into a wall power outlet. 6.



If you have difficulty with your phone, please try the suggestions listed below. As a general rule, if a problem occurs, remove the batteries from all the handsets in your installation for about 1 minute, then disconnect and reconnect the power supply to the base and reinstall the handset batteries.


#### Installing the handsets and **Charging the Batteries**

- 1. Slide down to open the battery compartment cover.
- 2. Place the 2 supplied rechargeable batteries as indicated. Pay extra attention to direction of polarity
- 3. Slide the battery compartment cover back.

Put the handset on the base or on the charger and charge for **15 hours** before using the 4. handset for the first time. The handset will emit a beep when it is properly placed on the base or charger.

Always use the rechargeable batteries provided in the box.



#### Notes:

If you need to remove the batteries, slide open the battery compartment cover and using the finger hole, grip the batteries and gently pull them out.




