
### **FIRST INSTALLATION**

# 1 Connecting the Base


- 1. Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the telephone jack on base bottom. (Fig. A)
- 2. Plug the small end of power adapter into a power jack on base bottom. (Fig. B)
- 3. Plug the large end of power adapter into a wall power outlet. (Fig. C)
- 4. Plug the other end of the telephone line cord in to the telephone jack or micro-filter.
- 5. Always use the cables provided in the box.
- 5. For Duo version, plug the power adaptor of the charger into a wall power outlet.



# Installing the handsets and Charging the Batteries

- 1. Slide down to open the battery compartment cover.
- Place the 2 supplied rechargeable batteries as indicated. Pay extra attention to direction of polarity.
- 3. Slide the battery compartment cover back.
- 4. Put the handset on the base or on the charger and charge for **15 hours** before using the handset for the first time. The handset will emit a beep when it is properly placed on the base or charger.

Always use the rechargeable batteries provided in the box.



#### Notes:

If you need to remove the batteries, slide open the battery compartment cover and using the finger hole, grip the batteries and gently pull them out.

# First settings before use

After first time power up (base unit is connected to AC mains), welcome mode message will appear on the screen (Fig.1).

## ? Troubleshooting

If you have difficulty with your phone, please try the suggestions listed below. As a general rule, if a problem occurs, remove the batteries from all the handsets in your installation for about 1 minute, then disconnect and reconnect the power supply to the base and reinstall the handset batteries.



Press  $\begin{pmatrix} \text{OK} \\ \text{MENU} \end{pmatrix}$ , press  $\begin{pmatrix} \mathbf{A} \end{pmatrix}$  or  $\begin{pmatrix} \mathbf{\nabla} \end{pmatrix}$  to select **DELETE**, press  $\begin{pmatrix} \mathbf{A} \end{pmatrix}$  or  $\begin{pmatrix} \mathbf{\nabla} \end{pmatrix}$  to select number to be deleted, press ( DK MENU ).

#### 1.4.2. Delete all numbers from blacklist

- 1. Repeat step 1 and 2 in Section 1.2.
- 2. Press  $\binom{\text{QK}}{\text{MENU}}$ , press  $(\mathbf{A})$  or  $(\mathbf{\nabla})$  to select **DELETE ALL**, press  $\binom{\text{QK}}{\text{MENU}}$ , **CONFIRM?** is shown, and then press  $\binom{\square K}{MENU}$  to confirm.

#### 2.2. Contacts only

In this broad automatic mode, only calls from contacts registered in your phonebook (normal and VIP) will go through and make your phone ring.

# Handset paging / Registration

#### Paging (Handset search)

Short press on (Fig.D) located under the base.

The handset will ring for 60 seconds. Press any keypad key on handset to stop ringing.

#### Handset registration

For multi-handset models, all handsets supplied are already associated with the base station. Pairing is only necessary if you purchase an Alcatel F860 Extra Handset (4 handsets max. per base) or when replacing a defective handset.

Press and hold for about 8 seconds.

**PIN?** will display (if not, select **REGISTRATION** with (▲) or (▼) Enter the default PIN: 0000 (can be modified in BS settings menu )
