



ENGLISH

BEFORE 1st USE

Connecting your phone:

- Connect plugs in corresponding sockets in the base station.
 - Plug the telephone line into telephone socket and insert power plug in an electrical outlet.
- Insert batteries in the handset and place it on its base to start charging.

Before you start to use your telephone, charge batteries continuously for **15 hours**.

▲ Use only plug adapter and rechargeable batteries supplied with your phone.

After first time power up (base unit is connected to AC mains), welcome mode message will appear on the screen (Fig.1)

Select the country where you are using the phone and confirm.

To select a different language, see Table 1.

HANDSET / BASE STATION KEYS

- 1. MENU/OK key
- 2. Back/Correction/Intercom key
- Navigation key/Call log access*/ Volume level increase
- 4. Navigation key/Volume level decrease
- 5. Talk key/Handsfree
- 6 Hang-up/Exit key
- 7. Direct access key to answering machine menu
- 8. Phonebook key
- 9. Call Block key*
- 10. Recall (Flash) key
 - To access to operator services*
- Redial list access

 (in standby mode : press and hold)
- 12. Paging key

DISPLAY ICONS

- Battery level indicator (full , mid , empty □).
- Indicates that phone is on line or held.

 Icon blinks when receiving an incoming call.
- Indicates you have a new voice mail message*.
- Answering machine is on; blinking in case of new message
- Indicates you have new missed calls*.
- Displays when the alarm clock is activated.
- Displays when handsfree is activated.
- Displays when ringer volume is turned off.

 Indicates that the handset is registered and
- within range of the base station.
 Icon blinks when the handset is out of range or is searching for a base.

GENERAL SETTINGS

This phone can be customized according to your preferences, to access the different possibilities press: $_{\text{DK}}^{\text{DK}}$

- To change Pin code, Flash time: A or ▼ select BS SETTINGS / DK

For example, to change language or flashtime:

- □K / ▲ or ▼ select HS SETTINGS / □K / ▲ or ▼ select LANGUAGE / □K / ▲ or ▼ select your desired language / □K / □K

To register a handset (if needed):

On main base, press and hold for 10s the paging key \P (number \P).

On the handset to be registered: press / $^{\square K}_{MENU}$ / \blacktriangledown / select **REGISTRATION** / press $^{\square K}_{MENU}$ / enter PIN code (default 0000) / press $^{\square K}_{MENU}$, handset is paired in few seconds.

To make an internal call

- If only 2 registered handsets: ^C_{NT}.
- If more than 2 registered handsets: $\frac{C}{NT} / \Delta$ or ∇ select the handset number $/ \frac{C}{MFNI}$.
- To ring all handsets to intercom: $_{\rm NT}^{\rm C}$ / $_{\rm A}$ or $_{\rm NT}^{\rm C}$ select CALL ALL / $_{\rm MENU}^{\rm CK}$.

To make a three-party conference call (with one external, two internals):

During call:

- Press / ^{□K}_{MENU} / select INTERCOM / ^{□K}_{MENU} / ▲ or ▼ select the handset number / ^{□K}_{MENU} .
- Press (on the called handset to answer.
- Press and hold for 2 seconds * on the calling handset to establish conference call.

PHONEBOOK AND DIRECT MEMORIES SETTINGS

To register in phonebook (50 entries)

To register the direct memories in keys 1, 2, & 3 $\stackrel{\text{DK}}{\text{MENU}}$ / \triangle or \bigcirc select HS SETTINGS / $\stackrel{\text{DK}}{\text{MENU}}$ / \triangle or \bigcirc select DIRECT MEM / $\stackrel{\text{DK}}{\text{MENU}}$ / \triangle or \bigcirc select one key (Key 1, Key 2, Key 3) / $\stackrel{\text{DK}}{\text{MENU}}$ / enter the number / $\stackrel{\text{CK}}{\text{MENU}}$. Notes:

- Phonebook is shared with duo, trio handsets.

ANSWERING MACHINE SETTING BY HANDSET

Set the answer mode

Set answer delay

 $_{\text{MENU}}^{\text{DK}}$ / ♠ or ▼ to select **ANS.MACHINE** / $_{\text{MENU}}^{\text{DK}}$ / ♠ or ▼ to select **TAM SETTING** / $_{\text{MENU}}^{\text{DK}}$ to select **ANSWER DELAY** / $_{\text{MENU}}^{\text{DK}}$ / ♠ or ▼ to select **2-10 RINGS** / $_{\text{MENU}}^{\text{DK}}$. If you have subscribed to a voice mail service from your Operator, make sure to set shorter delay on your phone, so that your phone can answer and record a message.

ANSWERING MACHINE USE BY HANDSET

You can control the Answering Machine by short cuts on the keypad instead of going through the menu.

Turn the answering machine on or off

๑ / **∆** or \triangledown to select **TAM ON/OFF** / $^{\text{OK}}_{\text{MENU}}$ / **△** or \triangledown to select **ON** or **OFF** / $^{\text{OK}}_{\text{MENU}}$.

Playback/Delete messages/Others

MSG PLAYBACK / MENU / to start playback in handsfree mode. While you are listening to a message, press (5°) to stop / (5°) to go forward / (1°) to go backward / (2°) to delete message.

Answering machine menu can also be reached by: $_{MENU}^{\square K}$ / \triangle or \triangledown to select **ANS. MACHINE** / $_{MENU}^{\square K}$

Remote access to answering machine

Dial your home phone number. While the answering machine is playing the outgoing message, press * and enter remote access code (default 0000).

CALL BLOCK OVERVIEW

This telephone is built-in with Basic Call Block feature*. This feature will help you avoid nuisance calls by only allowing some numbers to make your phone ring. Default setting of Basic Call Block in this telephone is **OFF** but you can enable it via your phone settings, as explained in the following paragraphs.

*This feature requires a subscription of Caller Line Identification service from your telephone service provider.

Setting	Explanations			
OFF	Call Block function (Block all call with numbers) is Disabled. This is the default mode.			
ON	Call Block function is set to On. Numbers registered in the black list will not go through and the phone will ring silently. Numbers can be added to the list while the phone is ringing and / or after a call (to enable, see part 1).			
ANONYM	This extra feature allows you to block call that do not have a number attached to them (ie private calls, international calls, etc). This option can be enabled on top of any of the previous (to enable, see part 2).			

1. Manual call block mode

Manual call block is the easiest option when starting out. When you chose **ON** in the call block settings, all calling numbers <u>registered in your blacklist</u> will be blocked. You can add/remove numbers from that list at any time.

How to block an incoming call:

When the phone is ringing and before answering, press will terminate the call and offer you the option to register the number to the blacklist in one click. Then to confirm the registration of this number in the blacklist, press \mathbb{Q}_N^{KU} .

IMPORTANT: if you don't confirm, the number will not be added to the blacklist and the next call will go through normally.

- Press Min , press A or ▼ to select CALL BLOCK
 Press Min , press A or ▼ to select BLOCK SET.
- 2. Press Menu , press A or T to select BLUCK SET.
- 3. Press $\mathbb{A}^{K}_{\text{NNU}}$, press \triangle or ∇ to select **ON**. OR In idle mode, press \bigcirc to access **BLOCK SET.** directly.

After you enable this option, the call block icon will be displayed on the LCD.

1.2. Add numbers to Blacklist

In idle mode,

- 1. Press & key, BLOCK SET. is displayed.
- 2. Press ♠ or ♥ to select **BLOCKLIST**.
- Press ^{MEN}_{MENU}, press ▲ or ▼ to select ADD, press ^{MENU}_{MENU}, enter number to be blocked, press ^{MENU}_{MENU} to save.

NOTE: 2 more ways to add incoming and outgoing call numbers in Block list:

- 1. From incoming call numbers
- Press ♣ or ▼ to select **CALL LIST**.
- Press OK , press ▲ or ▼ to select call list entry.
- Press $\stackrel{\text{OK}}{\text{MENU}}$, press \triangle or ∇ to select **ADD to BLIST**.
- Press MR to show selected number, press MR to save to **Block list**.
- 2. From outgoing call numbers
- Press lacktriangle , press lacktriangle or lacktriangle to select redial list entry.
- Press ^{OK}_{MENU} , press ▲ or ▼ to select **ADD to BLIST**.
- Press MENU to show selected number, press MENU to save to **Block list**.

1.3. Edit numbers in Blacklist

In idle mode,

- Repeat step 1 and 2 in Section 1.2.
- Press ⋈ , press or to select EDIT ⋈ , press or to select number to be edited, press ⋈ to edit, and then press ⋈ to save.

1.4. Delete numbers in Blacklist

1.4.1. Delete a number from blacklist In idle mode.

1. Repeat step 1 and 2 in Section 1.2.

Press ⋈ , press or to select **DELETE**, press to r to select number to be deleted, press ⋈ , to **CONFIRM?**

1.4.2.Delete all numbers from blacklist

In idle mode,

- 1. Repeat step 1 and 2 in Section 1.2.
- 2. Press (MN), press △ or ▼ to select **DELETE ALL**, press (MN), **CONFIRM?** is shown, and then press (MN) to confirm.

2. Anonymous call block mode

This feature allows you to block numbers that do not display a number on your phone. It can be enabled or disabled independently from the previous call block modes.



- 1. Press $^{OK}_{MENU}$, press \triangle or ∇ to select **CALL BLOCK**.
- Press ^{OK}_{MENJ} , press ▲ or ▼ to select BLOCK ANONYM.
- Press ^{OK}_{MENU}, press ▲ or ▼ to select one of the options.

2.1. Block Private Calls

This mode will block incoming calls that have been purposely kept their numbers private from you. In idle mode,

- 2. Press ♠ or ▼ to select **BLOCK ANONYM.**
- Press ^{OK}_{MENU} , press ▲ or ▼ to select PRIVATE, press ^{OK}_{MENU} to confirm.
- 4. will be displayed on the upper side of LCD.

2.2. Block All Anonymous Calls

This mode will block all incoming annonymous calls, including private calls, international calls, pay phone and other out-of-area calls.

In idle mode,

- 1. Repeat step 1 and 2 in Section 2.1.
- Press MENU , press ▲ or ▼ to select ALL, press MENU to confirm.
- 3. will be displayed on the upper side of LCD.

2.3. Set Block Anonymous Calls OFF

In idle mode,

- 1. Repeat step 1 and 2 in Section 2.1.
- Press [™]_{MKI}, press [™]_A or [™]
 to select **OFF**, press [™]_{MKI}
 to confirm.
- will only disappear from the LCD if the regular call block (see 1. and 2.) us also set to OFF.

TROUBLESHOOTING

As a general rule, if a problem occurs, remove the batteries from all handsets for about 1 minute, then disconnect and reconnect the power supply to the base and reinstall the handset batteries.


