



Phone web interface

- 1. Press (v) to check phone IP address or Menu > Status.
- 2. Open a web browser on your computer. Enter http:// and the IP address in the address bar and validate.
- 3. Default login and password are « admin/admin » for administrator.
- 4. Minimum config is sip account. Check administrator guide for details.

Note: you can also configure the phone through its menu. Press Menu > System (default pwd 123). then select **Network** and/or **Accounts** to edit relevant parameters and press (ok).

Language setting

- Press Menu > Basic > Language.
- Select the desired language and press (OK)

Making a call

- · Pre-dialling: enter the phone number and pick up the handset.
- Direct dialling: lift the handset and enter the phone number.
- Handsfree: enter phone number and press or vice versa.
- Headset: enter phone number and press or vice versa.
- With a specific outbound line: press the desired line key, dial the number and press Dial.

Accepting a call

- With the handset: pick up the handset.
- With a headset: press

Putting a call on hold

· Press Hold softkey. To retrieve the call press Resume soft key.

Note: with more than one active call, select desired call with the navigator keys Qoo and use the corresponding soft key to hold or resume.

Multi-party conference

- 1. Once in line with 1st caller, press Conf soft key, 1st caller is put on hold.
- 2. Then call the 2nd number.
- 3. After, 2nd call is established, press **Conf** soft key to set up the conference.

Call transfer

Attended transfer:

- 1. Press Xfer soft key during the active conversation, the call is put on hold.
- 2. Dial the second telephone number.
- 3. When the call is answered, press **Xfer** soft key to complete the operation.

Blind transfer:

- 1. Press **Xfer** soft key during the active conversation, the call will be on hold.
- 2. Then enter the 2nd telephone number and press again Xfer soft key.

Kevpad lock

- 3. Anytime, select Paired device and Enter in Bluetooth menu to see your devices. Press Link to connect.

Programmable keys

Program DSS keys:

- 1. You can use the phone web interface to configure the keys at both sides of the display, or
- 2. You can press any or these keys which is still blank, select a function, value and key name and press (ok), or
- 3. You can go to Menu > Basic > Keyboard > DSS Key Settings.

Select the key, function and value if needed and press (ox).

Program other keys:

- 1. You can also configure the 2 line keys, shortcuts for the navigation keys, and which softkeys will be displayed in idle mode.

Redial

Voice mail

- 1. To access your voice mailbox, press, (or highlight on-screen on shortcut with right navigation key and then (cx). Number of messages will be indicated if provided by your server or pbx.
